

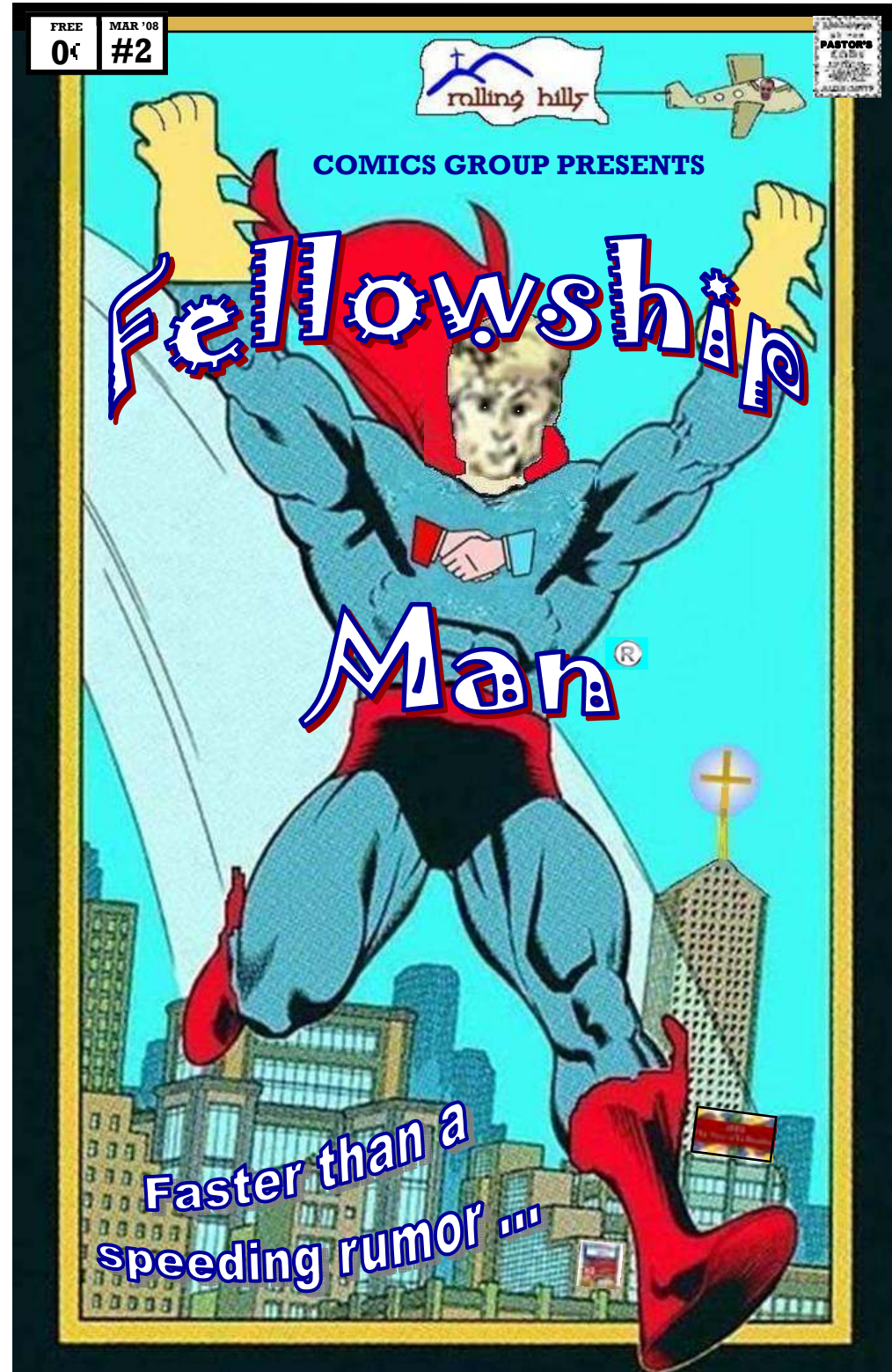
Hey, Kids!

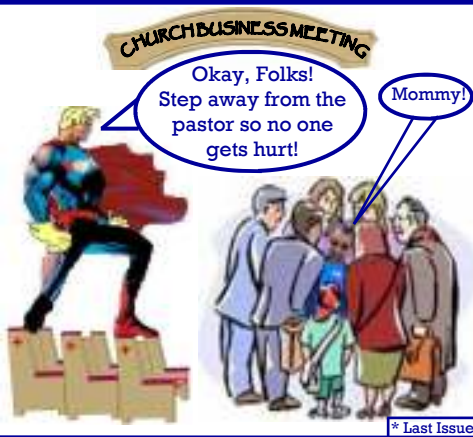
