T.V. Land—Episode 3: “Father Knows Best”

The Lordship of Christ over My Decisions

*“For you know that we dealt with each of you as a father deals with his own children, encouraging, comforting and urging you to live lives worthy of God, who calls you into his kingdom and glory.”
(1 Thessalonians 2:11-12)*

How to Commit My Decisions to the Lord:

1) Seeking Your Father’s WILL

“Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my will, but yours be done.” (Luke 22:42)

“For my Father’s will is that everyone who looks to the Son and believes in him shall have eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day.” (John 6:40)

2) Asking Daddy for the KEYS
